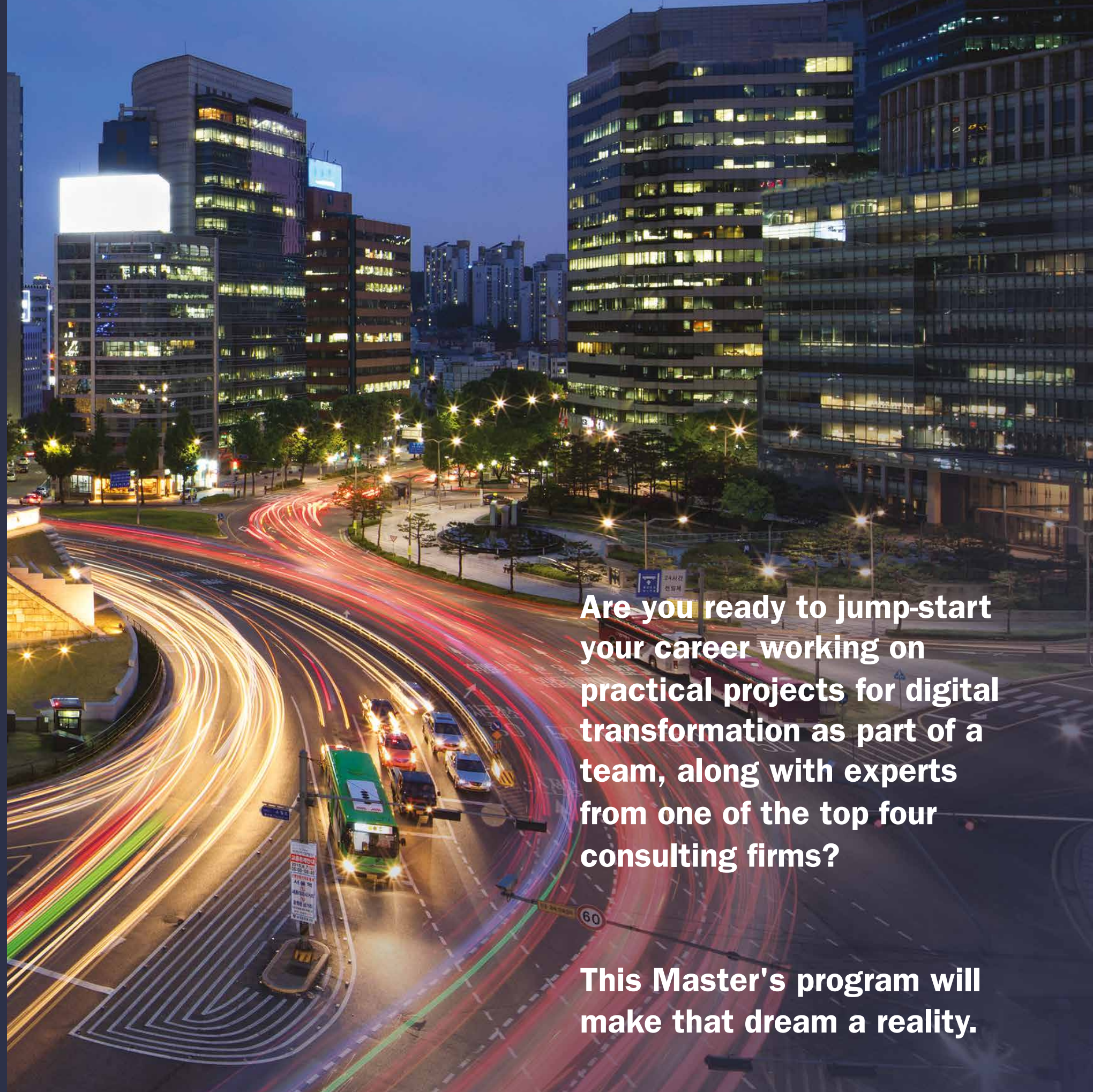

Scholarship Opportunity

The Responsible Leadership Scholarship program is a merit award for qualified students accepted into the MSIM program.

It was established to recognize individuals who clearly demonstrate a deep commitment to leading positive change in organizations and communities. Awards are in the amount CHF 6,250 (25% of the tuition fee).

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- be EU and/or EEA citizen;
- demonstrate maturity, flexibility, and leadership potential in the field of responsible management in either Climate Action;
- have an earned bachelor's degree with an excellent academic record;
- demonstrate proficiency in English;
- be able to receive and maintain a visa or study permit as required by Switzerland.
