

Franklin University Switzerland seeks applications for the position of Assistant Professor of International Relations and Political Science. The position is full-time, renewable and with a clear promotion ladder, and would begin in August 2019, pending funding.

The successful candidate will have a Ph.D. with specialization in Political Economy and further expertise in Public Administration or Comparative Politics. Applicants will also be able to teach undergraduate courses ranging from the introductory level to thesis supervision. Consistent with the mission of the University, applicants must demonstrate a commitment to excellence in both teaching and scholarship, have an active research agenda, and contribute to the Academic Travel program, a fundamental component of Franklin's international, intercultural, and interdisciplinary curriculum. Ideally, candidates will be conversant in one of the official languages of Switzerland, have a global outlook, and demonstrate an interest in collaborating across disciplines.
